

CERTIFIED MORTGAGE BANKER (CMB)



Earning Your CMB

All CMB candidates must accumulate 150 points from the following three categories — Professional Experience (25-75), Documented Education (35-75), and Industry Participation (25-75) — before taking the CMB evaluation. If you have been in the mortgage banking industry for three years or more, you may already have accumulated many of the 150 points required. Go to www.campusmba.org/cmb to estimate your current point balance.

The CMB Evaluation

The CMB evaluation includes a written and oral exam. CMB Prep Courses designed to help prepare for the CMB written exam are offered throughout the year. These six-week instructor-led web-based courses are led by Certified Mortgage Banker designees. Go to www.campusmba.org/cmb for a current list of CMB Prep Course offerings and oral exam dates.

Choosing Your Path

There are three CMB designations — Residential, Commercial and Master. The Master designation is available to those who have already attained Residential or Commercial CMB status. All CMBs are recognized as members of a select group of influential leaders within the mortgage banking industry.
